



Ethical Issues of eHealth: an Integrative Review Update.

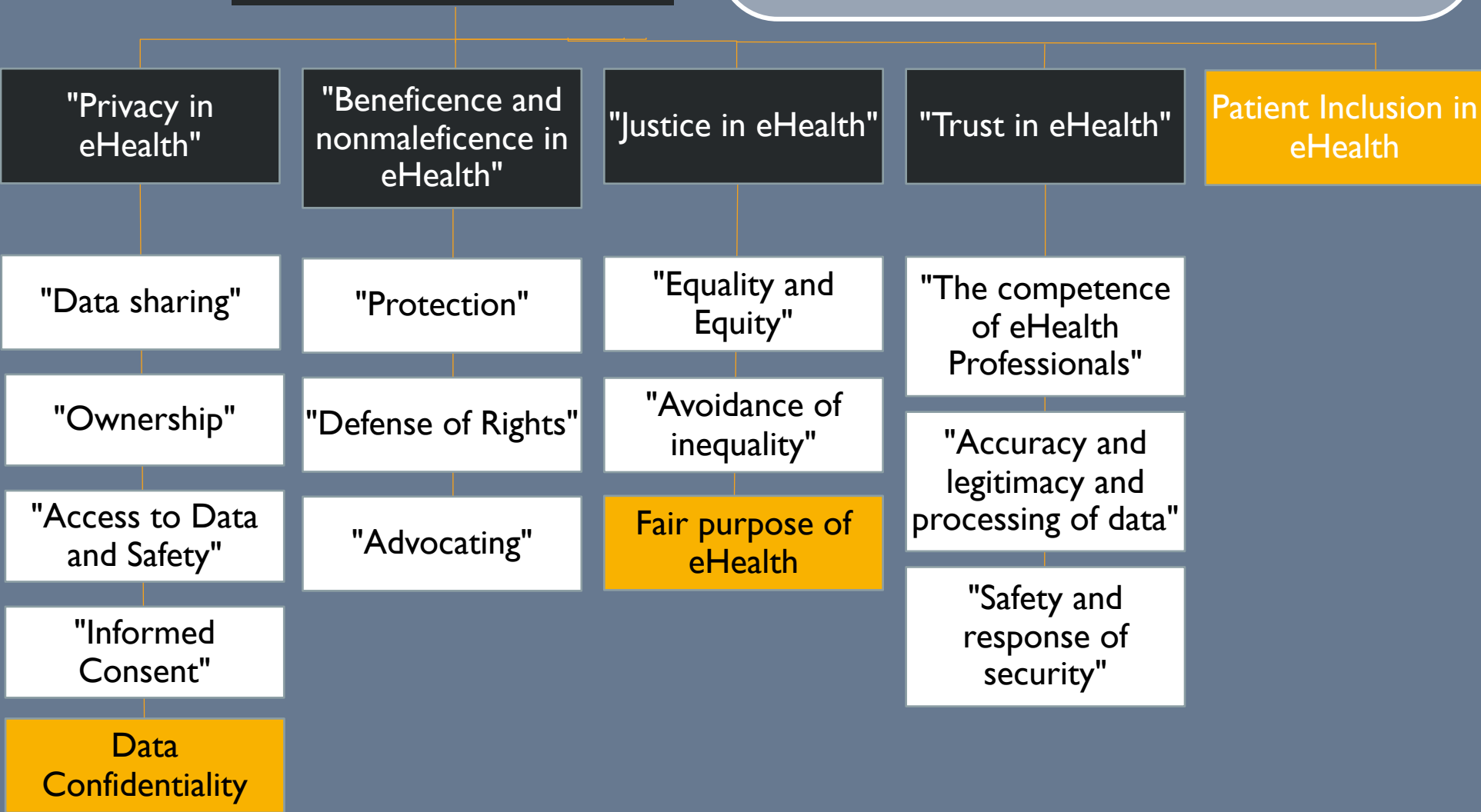
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BACKGROUND: A previous integrative review identified ethical issues related to eHealth from the perspective of users (Jokinen et al. 2021). We updated this review to identify **new ethical issues in eHealth**, especially in times of the COVID-19 Pandemic.

AIMS: To identify the ethical issues related to the use of eHealth in healthcare from the service users' perspective

RESULTS: Ethical Issues of eHealth

METHOD: An integrative review was carried out according to the approach used by Jokinen et al. (2021) in the initial review. A systematized literature search was performed on relevant sources to find studies with a defined time frame:



CONCLUSION: We conclude that the ethical issues already identified are maintained, but new issues have arisen. These new questions refer to the need to include the patient in decision-making in eHealth, the need for fair care and need for data confidentiality.
